

KINGSVILLE TOWNSHIP SPECIAL MEETING

AUGUST 2, 2010 - 7:00 pm - KINGSVILLE FIRE HALL

A special meeting of the Kingsville Township Trustees was called to order by Mr. Doug Reed, Chairman. This meeting is for the purpose of completing the levy paperwork now that certification from the Auditor has been received and passing the resolution for them to be taken to the Board of Elections.

Present were: Mr. Doug Reed, Mr. Darrell Ensman, Mr. Dennis Huey, and Fiscal Officer Debbie Ball.

OLD BUSINESS:

NEW BUSINESS: 1) Mr. Huey gave report on the certification from the Auditor for what each levy would bring in for revenue at the replacement and renewal mils. The papers also state what the total tax valuation for the subdivision is.

The estimated combined tax revenue for the 1.5 Road and Bridge Renewal is \$46825.62.

The estimated combined tax revenue for the 1.5 Fire and EMS Replacement is \$50772.62.

The estimated combined tax revenue for the 4.0 Road and Bridge Replacement is \$135393.33.

The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$33,744,570.00.

2) Mr. Huey made a motion to adopt a Resolution to place on the November 2010 ballot, for a term of 5 years, a 1.5 mil Road and Bridge Renewal Levy; Mr. Ensman seconded; all yes.

3) Mr. Huey made a motion to adopt a Resolution to place on the November 2010 ballot, for a term of 5 years, a 4.0 mil Road and Bridge Replacement Levy; Mr. Ensman seconded; all yes.

4) Mr. Huey made a motion to adopt a Resolution to place on the November 2010 ballot, for a term of 5 years, a 1.5 mil Fire and EMS Replacement Levy; Mr. Ensman seconded; all yes.

Once adopted and signed, a copy of each resolution will be taken to the Board of Elections in Jefferson and filed for the November ballot.

The resolutions were signed by all parties. Mr. Huey will take them to Jefferson tomorrow and get them filed.

With no further business to address, Mr. Reed moved to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Mr. Huey; all yes.
