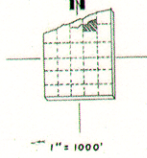


Kingsville Township Zoning Map

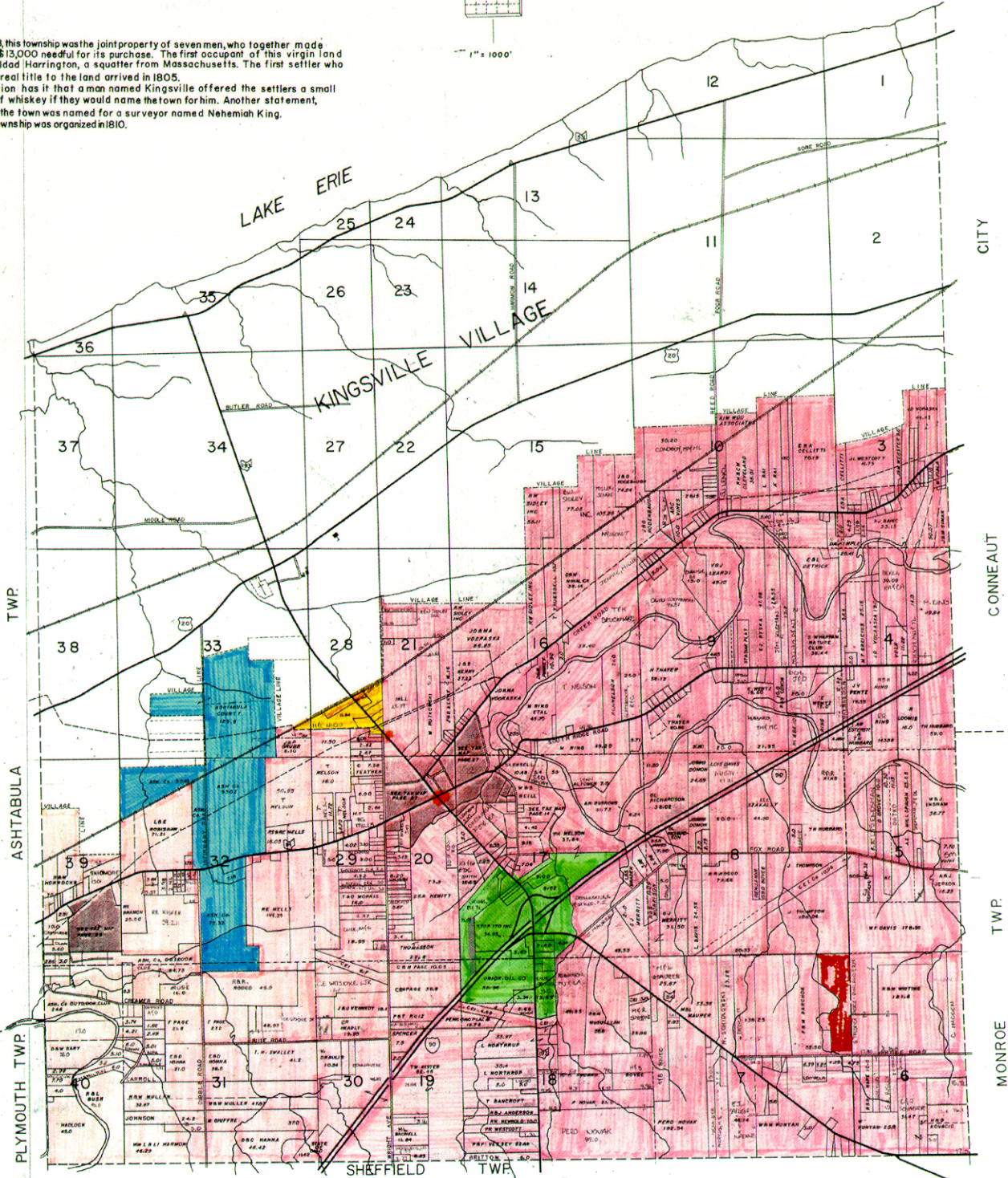

In 1798, this township was the joint property of seven men, who together made up the \$13,000 needful for its purchase. The first occupant of this virgin land was Eldad Harrington, a squatter from Massachusetts. The first settler who had a real title to the land arrived in 1805. Tradition has it that a man named Kingsville offered the settlers a small keg of whiskey if they would name the town for him. Another statement, is that the town was named for a surveyor named Nehemiah King. The township was organized in 1810.
